Your exam today may include **Refraction**, which is the part of the exam that calculates your glasses or contact lens prescription. **Most insurance companies do not pay for the Refraction, regardless of your diagnosis.** If you have a **Refraction** as part of your exam today **you will be responsible** for paying the **\$30.00** charge along with your co-pay, co-insurance or deductible.



A **Contact Lens Fitting** is required for the physician to know what type of contact to prescribe. There is a fee for **Contact Lens Fitting**. **Your insurance does not pay for this service** and **you will be responsible** to pay the appropriate fee along with your co-pay, co-insurance or deductible.
